The Sutter Creek Police Department in partnership with the Amador County Sheriff's Office has implemented CodeRED, a high-speed emergency/community notification solution provided by Emergency Communications Network to help keep residents and businesses informed with important information that may immediately impact their safety. Watch the video to see how CodeRED works.

Please note, if you are unsure of whether your contact information is in the database or if you have recently moved or changed your telephone number, it is important to click on the above CodeRED emergency notifications link to add or update your information.

Amador County will use the CodeRED system to notify the entire county or specific areas within the county of important information. The CodeRED system will deliver telephone calls, text messages and emails. Messages may regard evacuations, police activity, missing children, boil water notices or other information.

Please listen to each message carefully.

You may opt-in to receive emergency and community notifications by clicking on the above CodeRED emergency notifications link.

CA VINE

The California Statewide VINE system is a service through which victims of crime can use the telephone or Internet to search for information regarding the custody status of their offender and to register to receive telephone and e-mail notification when the offender's custody status changes.

The VINE toll-free number for the California Statewide VINE system is 1-877-411-5588.

VINE now offers a mobile app called VINEMobile. VINEMobile is an on-the-go version of VINE that allows access from your mobile device, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It is completely free and anonymous for users.
